ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF FEES AND EXPENSES

On this day came on to be heard the *Application for Approval of Fees and Expenses* (“Application”) filed by Resolution Oversight Corporation, Special Deputy Receiver (“SDR”) of the Grand Court Order of Calanthe.

The Application was properly submitted to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding. The Special Master has issued a report pursuant to Rule 171 of the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure which is incorporated herein, finding that notice of the Application was proper and no objection was filed, and recommending that the Application should be granted.


Having considered the Application, and accepted the report of the Special Master, the Court finds as follows:

1. The *Order of Reference to Master* (“Order of Reference”) provides that motions filed pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.015 are referred to the Special Master appointed in this proceeding;
2. Notice of the Application was provided in accordance with TEX. INS. CODE ANN. §443.007 (d) and the Order of Reference;
3. No objections to the Application were filed;
4. The Court has jurisdiction over the Application; and
5. The SDR’s Application should be granted in all respects.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

1. The Application is GRANTED in all respects.
2. The hourly rates of compensation for the SDR and the contractors listed on Exhibit A to the Application are approved; and the flat fee of \$2,150.00 for the Warren Group for preparing each annual Federal Income tax return for the estate is hereby approved.
3. The SDR is authorized to pay customary expenses as necessary to conduct Calanthe's operations.
4. The SDR shall file with this Court a summary of expenses pursuant to TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 443.015 (g) on a quarterly basis as described in Paragraph 3.6 of the Application.
5. This order constitutes a final judgment fully resolving all issues relating to the Application.


